Oral Health Value-Based Care Training Program

The Training Program will highlight best practices in the existing fee-for-service system, but will also emphasize elements that prepare programs to more efficiently transition into value-based care. Participants will learn:

- What value-based care means relative to oral health

- How to identify areas that need to be improved to prepare for inclusion in a value-based care system
- Examples of different value-based payment and care models
- What potential goals and quality metrics could be incorporated in an OHVBC system
- How to transform from a fee-for-service payment system to a value-based payment model
- How to evaluate the OHVBC system and its effectiveness
- Examples of person-centered models of care through interprofessional practice
