DentaQuest Partnership Invests \$640,000 in Oral Health Initiatives During Third Quarter

On Oct. 31, the DentaQuest Partnership announced the investment of \$640,000 in organizations across the U.S. dedicated to improving the oral health of all. This announcement captures grants awarded in the third quarter, with a total of \$9.6 Million awarded to-date. Our grantmaking strategy focuses on investments that drive systems change in oral health through national and community-based initiatives in key focus areas, including integration of oral health into person-centered healthcare.
